



## Art History Periods

If you would like some knowledge of art history and its chronological order, here's one way of learning it quickly and easily.

Play a few rounds of matching works of art with this gameboard and you should, within thirty minutes, have the ability to not only recogize the period's name, but to recall its location on the board as well. If, for example, you've played Monopoly, you know the location and color of Park Place without consciously memorizing this information. This gameboard works the same way.

Begin by taking a quick lap or two around the board to become familiar with the whole layout. Next, tackle the sample matching below. Finally, match game cards with the gameboard.
